Rescind Bid for Construction of Cemetery Boundary Wall Project: Civil Engineer, Jeff Voss, provided further information regarding the cement wall extension. He said there were alternatives that were not considered. Jeff Voss suggested there were other options for fencing and reviewed the advantages of vinyl fencing. It is environmentally friendly, has a limited lifetime warranty and a selection of colors and materials. The cost would be approximately \$75 - \$100 a linear foot. Trustee Flood motioned to rescind the motion from the special meeting of September 1, 2016 to accept the bid from Mark Wallace Masonry in the amount of \$92,877.00, with the start date of October 1, 2016 and was seconded by Trustee Askins. The motion passed 5-0. Trustee Askins motioned to proceed with vinyl fencing, get pricing, with samples for the Trustees to review and was seconded by Trustee Vogel. The motion passed 5-0. Chairman Clouse asked DM Young to write letters to Mark Wallace and Charles Kaplan advising them of the Board's decision not to construct a block wall on our property.
