Finance Committee Report: Trustee Dodds reported that the Committee met, reviewed the claims and recommends approval for \$78,666.46 under the Consent Calendar.

SDAC Report: Trustee Flood reported that the Water District has sustainable ground water. There was talk about budget updates and staffing and, seating representatives on LAFCo. Let representatives now about the services their District's provide. Also, there was discussion on small Districts to get affordable websites.
